2 GIANT Pool Balls: Sculpture `77

3 Westphalian Service Centre

The location of Muenster assumes responsibility for central functions for a region with more than 1.5 million inhabitants. The service sector is the city's most important sector of the economy. 82.7 percent of the employees who are in employment subject to social insurance contributions work here. Established office locations are booming, there is a large concentration of higher central authorities, chambers, large banks and insurance companies.



4 Felix Nussbaum House

Osnabrueck sees the historical legacy of the peace treaty from 1648 in Osnabrueck Town Hall as being a mission to commit itself to peace politics, both outside and within urban society. Felix Nussbaum House is an excellent contribution to this, it having been built in accordance with a concept from the American architect Daniel Libeskind.

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6 Competence Centres

7 XL Business Park

Created as an industrial park, a high-quality, future-oriented and secure industrial location with a total area of 180,000 m² is being developed here. The XL Business Park is especially oriented towards company from the logistics, transport and freight forwarding branches. Companies from other branches with a large site requirement (min. 2 ha) will however also find an attractive location here.



8 WTC/Twente Main Railway Station

The WTC Twente is being developed in the heart of the euregional traffic hub. The WTC and the main railway station are a part of the large Hart van Zuid project. This concerns itself with the surface recycling or revitalisation of old industrial wasteland with a total area of 50 ha. urban renewal and new utilisation concepts create a modern and lively city quarter, where living, working, recreation & relaxation go hand in hand.



9 Twente Kennispark

An industrial park for research and knowledge-based companies. High-quality and sustainable jobs, in that innovation, an exchange of knowledge and experience, entrepreneurship and the designing of an inspiring and a green environment are effectively linked to each other.
