I do not know the full facts in relation to Hans Calmeyer.

I have, however, sought to inform myself by independent means as to the material that is generally available.

It is apparent that reasonable, informed and independent persons have raised serious concerns about aspects of his actions and role in the Netherlands under its occupation after 1940.

Adopting a precautionary approach is, in these circumstances, justifiable. This suggests that in the face of information as to real and reasonable uncertainty it would be premature to honour a memorial space with the name of a particular person until it is established beyond reasonable doubt that this person had no involvement in actions which, if they were to be established, would cause a different decision to be taken.

In the present situation, as matters stand, the application of a precautionary approach suggests a clear path of direction until such time as the available information indicates otherwise."
